2.	Prepare a thin personal folder (Homework file): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ For notices, forms, letters or worksheets ○ To be brought to and from school ○ Parents are encouraged check on a daily basis with your child. 	
3.	Train child to take care of his/ her personal affairs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Eg. Hygiene needs (toilet training), tying of shoelaces, packing of school bag, clean up personal area after snack break 	
4.	Help your child to be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Write & recognize his/her full name ○ Write legibly and neatly in English and Mother Tongue ○ Use a ruler to draw straight lines
