Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome back to school! Term 3 promises to be an exciting and engaging term for all students. As we continue to enhance our school programmes to provide a unique Tampinesian brand of education, we continue to “Know Every Child, Grow Every Child and Celebrate Every Child”. Temperature Taking Exercise (TTEEx) 2nd July & 3rd July 2024

The TTEEx is to ensure staff and students are prepared for a pandemic. This exercise will help us to keep the school safe and opened for learning. There will be a pre-trial on Tuesday, 2nd July 2024 before the actual exercise on Wednesday, 3rd July 2024. Do help your children prepare for the exercise by reminding them to bring their Oral Digital Thermometers (ODTs) to school on both days. During the first Temperature Taking Exercise in January this year, we issued the ODTs to our P1 students and P1 teachers have kept them for safekeeping. Parents of P2 to P6 students should check that your child’s ODT is in working condition and if it is lost or damaged. ODTs can be purchased from the school’s bookshop. Do contact your child’s form teachers should you have any queries.

2024 P1 Registration Exercise - Phase 1 Registration

Phase 1 registration is for a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (PR) child born between 2 January 2018 and 1 January 2019 (both dates inclusive) and has a sibling currently studying in our school.

For the 2024 P1 Registration Exercise (**2024 P1 Ex**), parents who are registering their younger child under Phase 1 are to **register during the Phase 1 registration period from 2nd July 2024 (Tuesday), 9 am to 4th July 2024 (Thursday), 4.30 pm** through the P1 Registration Portal.

There is no school for all levels except for the Primary 5 level. All Primary 5 students will report to school for subject revision and the coding programme on all three days. P1 to P4 levels will have Home-based Learning during the period.

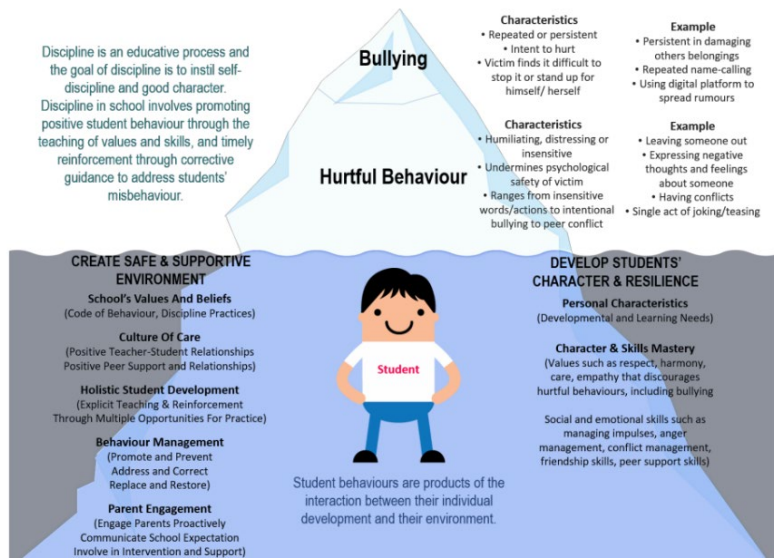
Important Reminders
