We welcome all students back to school and look forward to the final term of learning and consolidation.

### **PSLE Listening Comprehension (LC) Examination - Friday, 13<sup>th</sup> September 2024**

The PSLE Listening Comprehension Examination for P6 students will be on Friday, 13<sup>th</sup> September 2024. P6 students are to report punctually to the school hall at 8 a.m. Students who are exempted from Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) will report at 10.15 a.m. at the school hall.

P1 to P5 students do not report to school that day. They will be doing home-based learning.

### **Study Break before PSLE - Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2024 to Wednesday, 25<sup>th</sup> September 2024**

Parents of P6 students were previously informed of the Study Break from Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2024 to Wednesday, 25<sup>th</sup> September 2024. P6 students are to refer to the lesson schedule and zoom details that will be issued to them before the start of the study break.

Do note that school hours remain the same for all other P1 – P5 students.

### **PSLE Written Examination - Thursday, 26 September 2024 to Wednesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2024**

The PSLE Written Examinations are from Thursday, 26<sup>th</sup> September 2024 to Wednesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2024. All P6 students are to report punctually to the respective examination rooms at 7.30 a.m. They will be dismissed from school at the end of each paper. P1 to P5 students will attend school as usual.

### **Important Health Reminders**

To continue to keep our school a safe and happy place for all our students and staff, we remind parents on the importance of continued vigilance against contagious diseases. While the risk remains low, it is essential that we encourage your children to practice good personal hygiene. This includes regular handwashing with soap and water, not sharing food and drinks with friends, doing the routine wipe down his/her desk at the start of the day, and avoid close contact with anyone showing symptoms of rashes, fever, cough and runny nose. Should your child feel sick or unwell with flu-like symptoms, you are strongly encouraged to bring your child to see a doctor, and rest at home to recover. If your child is given medical leave, we strongly encourage you to let your child recover well and to return to school until after the full duration of the medical leave.

Our staff will be carrying out their daily visual wellbeing checks on all students and will remind them to practice good personal hygiene.

Let us continue to actively collaborate on the continual efforts to allow your child to learn and grow in a safe and happy school.

### **Conclusion**

To ensure the safety and care arrangements for your children, parents of children in TPPS Student Care Centre are reminded to confirm with the service providers their actual operating hours during school closures.

We understand that Term 4 might be a stressful period for both parents and students as your children revise for the coming P3 – P6 year-end assessments. Do remember to commend your children’s efforts and improvements as well and to care for their overall well-being. As parents, you can help your child find a good balance of revision, play and rest.
