- Friday, 3rd January 2025: All students (P1 to P6) report to school.

We would like to highlight that all primary students are strongly discouraged from bringing their handphones or wearing smartwatches (with recording and transmitting functions) to school. We gently remind parents of the school rules and regulations on the use of Mobile Phones and Smart Watches (Page 24 of the 2025 Student Diary). Handphones must be always switched off and communication capabilities for smart watches must be disabled within the school premises. All





















devices, if used inappropriately, will be confiscated and kept by the school until a parent comes to claim it. Students would need to face disciplinary consequences of any breach of this school rule. Students can continue to use their POSB Smartbuddy watches to purchase food in the canteen. We seek your active partnership to ensure that your child/ren adhere to these new school rules which will reduce the ill effects of screen time and will improve their self-discipline.
