This theme focuses on equipping individuals with the essential skills needed to navigate the digital world safely and confidently. We encourage you and your children to participate in initiatives organized by MLC that teach your children how to stay safe online, respond to and recover from encounters with online harms such as cyberbullying, inappropriate content and misinformation, and support peers who may be affected by such issues. Total Defence Day (TDD) Saturday,15th February 2025 & Exercise SG Ready 2025

Total Defence is relevant to deal with the ever-evolving threats and challenges to Singapore. These include misinformation, supply chain disruptions and food security, which affect communities and Singapore's way of life. Every Singaporean has a part to play to ensure that Singapore is prepared for crises and disruptions so that we remain resilient and united.

TPPS will commemorate Total Defence Day on Monday, 17th February 2025. The theme 'Together We Keep Singapore Strong' focuses on Singapore's readiness and resilience in the face of crises and disruptions. Our students will experience a **power disruption** simulation from 8.00 to 9.00 am and learn how to manage power failure in all the classrooms. This disruption exercise aims to prepare students for potential disruptions to our power supply (e.g. due to supply chain disruptions), given Singapore's reliance on fuel imports. In such a situation, electricity may have to be prioritised for more critical areas, and households and organisations, including schools, may have to endure disruptions in their power supply. Following the exercise, students will reflect on their experience and share their thoughts and feelings with their classmates through a guided discussion.
