Dear Parents/Guardians,

In line with the easing of national Safe Management Measures (SMMs), Tampines Primary will be also making adjustments to school operations and routines.

As school is overall considered as an indoor venue, we require all students to be mask-on when they enter the school. They will also need to have their working trace together tokens with them. They will remain mask-on for all indoor activities and teachers will be on hand to advise the students if they wish to be mask-off for outdoor activities such as PE and unstructured play.

From next Monday, 11 April 2022, Tampines Primary will resume morning assembly in the school hall for P1 – P5 students. P6 students will still continue to report to their individual classes. All staff and students can now sing the national anthem and take the pledge with masks on. Students are advised to bring a Mother Tongue story book for silent reading on Wednesdays and an English story book for all other school days.

For students who are in school early, before 7:40 a.m., they can go to the canteen to buy and eat their breakfasts. During this time, students can also buy snacks to bring to their classes for their snack breaks. Sale of food will stop at 7:40 a.m. until the first recess. Students are advised to adhere to all canteen SMMs including safe distancing and wipe down. Teachers and prefects will be on duty both in the canteen and the hall to ease the students into these routines. All students will need to be seated in the hall or in their classrooms by 7:50 a.m. as otherwise they will be marked as late for school.

Two of the key school celebrations that we can look forward to will be the prefect investiture as well as the staff promotion ceremony.

Our students can now enjoy the resumption of face-to-face co-curricular activities, Singapore Youth Festival celebrations and the National Primary School Sports Games. Teachers in-charge of individual programmes will be sending out further details to relevant parents via Parents Gateway.

For students who need to eat lunch after school, arrangements will be made for them to either eat their lunch in the canteen or to buy/pack their lunch from the canteen and bring it back to their classrooms.
