This programme began in May and the students spent their June holidays working collaboratively on their sustainability projects with their overseas peers. The presentation of projects will take place in Term 3.

#### **P4 Financial Literacy Programme**

As part of equipping every Tampinesian with the necessary skills to be a future-ready citizens, P4 students will be embarking on the inaugural Financial Literacy programme in Term 3. The programme prepares our students to be positive contributors to their communities by providing them with tools and opportunities to



















take charge of their financial future. Apart from developing financial literacy skills in our students, the programme also includes engagement with family.
