## National Pledge recited in Malay Language, Chinese Language and Tamil Language

The recitation of our National Pledge in the different mother tongue languages commenced from 20<sup>th</sup> March 2023. Students will be led through the National Pledge with Student Leaders leading the pledge in the different languages. To support our students' learning, the English translation will be shown to students as well. Your child has been encouraged to also teach their friends to practice reciting our National pledge in their own Mother Tongue Language during recess.

#### **International Friendship Day (IFD) 2023**

Schools commemorate International Friendship Day (IFD) on the third working Friday of Term 2. As Good Friday falls on the same day this year, we will commemorate IFD on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2023. This year, the theme for IFD is 'Singapore in Asia'.

International cooperation remains key in our complex world. Asia is the world's fastest-growing region, and Singapore continues to facilitate closer economic, political, social, and cultural cooperation within ASEAN and in Asia. By recognising the importance of connectedness between our neighbouring countries, our students can play an active role in fostering people-to-people ties and thus celebrate the region's diversity.

The IFD programmes include the TPPS Community Cafe song dedication hosted by NE Ambassadors, sing-along in multi-national languages, and recess programmes such as the Friendship Band Making and Padlet Reflection booths. In conjunction with Earth Day, TPPS will also incorporate the idea of 'Friends for a Better Ecological World' through an inter-class ASEAN mascot competition where recycled materials will be used. In line with our National Education Theme for 2023, 'The Arts', students will be engaged in a sharing on 'Arts and Heritage in Southeast Asia' as well as an assembly programme titled 'Mask Dancer'.

Through these vibrant and meaningful programmes, we hope that Tampinesians will be able to recognise and celebrate the diverse and colourful culture of Asia and nurture the spirit of friendship and collaboration among their peers.

#### **Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Fortnight**

Our school will be organizing a Mother Tongue Language Fortnight (MTL Fortnight) from 10<sup>th</sup> April to 21<sup>st</sup> April during curriculum time. The objective of the MTL Fortnight is to provide platforms for our students to actively learn their Mother Tongue Languages and culture to experience MTL as "Living Languages".
