### Dear Parents,

As Tampines Primary celebrates May Day, we want to show our deep appreciation and gratefulness to colleagues who have worked so hard to ensure the safety and cleanliness of our school compound. On behalf of our staff, students, and parents, I wish to pay a special tribute



to our security officers, our contract cleaning team headed by Mr Michael Leong and our School Admin Team. They ensure, daily, that Tampines Primary is

able to function well, serving to the holistic needs of all students. With the recent rise in Covid 19 and influenza A cases, the contract and

operations teams have stepped up the cleaning of common areas such as canteens, lifts, and toilets. They have also disinfected classrooms and high touch areas such as door handles and lift buttons.



## Important Reminders

In order to support their work and to ringfence the school, we gently remind parents that students should not come to school if they are sick or unwell with flu-like symptoms. As part of our social responsibility, you are strongly encouraged to only let your child return to school after the medical leave is completed, and when your child is well. Staff will be carrying out their daily visual wellbeing checks on all students. We will continue to encourage all students to practise personal hygiene by washing their hands frequently, wearing masks if necessary, doing the daily wipedowns and informing the teachers if they feel unwell. Let us continue to collaborate on the continual efforts to keep all students healthy and happy.

#### Maker Space Week

To support Tampines Primary's sustainability efforts and develop a growth mindset, the Maker Space Week will be held from 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2023 to 5<sup>th</sup> May 2023 for students to create useful objects using recyclables. Students will use recycled materials that they have collected in their class recycling bins to produce a range of upcycled art products integrating STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) concepts. There was palpable excitement among the students during morning assembly when they learnt about the possibilities of what they can do. We will post photos of them at work in our Instagram account.

## P5 and P3 Senior Olympics

Our P5 and P3 students will be participating in the Senior Olympics on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2023 (P5 Senior Olympics) and 17<sup>th</sup> May 2023 (P3 Senior Olympics) held during school hours. The objectives of the Senior Olympics games are to develop the character traits of sportsmanship and teamwork















through sports and games. Students will compete in team games against other classes at the same level. All students will have the opportunities to participate and represent their classes.

### Aesthetics Week

The students look forward to Aesthetics week to learn more of and expand their repertoire of music and art competencies. Varied, interactive and 'fun' activities will be held from 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2023 to 24<sup>th</sup> May 2023 for students to express themselves creatively. Art, Music, and Drama activities will be organized during the Early Bird Programme, Recess Activities and School Assembly.

## 2023 P1 Registration Exercise - Phase 1 Registration

The Primary 1 Phase 1 registration is for a Singapore Citizen (SC), or Permanent Resident (PR) child born between 2 January 2017 and 1 January 2018 (both dates inclusive) and has a sibling currently studying in our school. For the 2023 P1 Registration Exercise (2023 P1 Ex), parents who are registering their children under Phase 1 are to **register on-line during the Phase 1 registration period in early July 2023**.

If your child is a non-SC / non-PR and thus not eligible for Phase 1, please submit an online Indication of Interest in end May/early June 2023.

## Tree Planting on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2023
