Travel Declaration

To ensure that schools continue to be a healthy and safe environment for all, we require parents/guardians to make **a travel declaration for your child/ward if he/she will be travelling** for the holidays.

To make a travel declaration for your child/ward via Parents' Gateway (PG), go to [SERVICE > DECLARE TRAVELS].

- Please declare your child/ward's travel plan(s), indicating both the country and city of travel, and any city of transit, **by 26 May 2023 (the last day of the term)**. Only one parent/guardian is required to make the declaration.

If your child/ward is **not travelling** during the holidays, **no action is required**.

When planning your travel, please refer to <https://www.ica.gov.sg/enter-transit-depart> for more information and updates. **If there is a change in travel plan(s) after declaration, please submit a new travel declaration via PG or inform the school if the travel plan(s) are cancelled.**

Changes to Uniform & Play Venues (ending Term 2)

In view of the recent very warm weather and to help our students to remain comfortable, Tampines Primary School will implement the following changes until the end of Term 2, 2023. These are:

- No Uplay in the open field during recess
- Reminders on the need to drink water frequently to stay hydrated
- All PE lessons after 10.30 am will be held either in the shade or in-doors
- All students can wear their full PE attire, if they so wish, during the school day.

P6 students who return for the June holidays booster camp can wear their full PE attire if they wish.

We have also noticed that, despite reminders, many students are still not properly attired for PE and sports CCA sessions. For safety reasons, students will not be able to participate in PE, sports CCA or Olympics Day activities unless they are wearing the full PE attire.



We appreciate parents' support to help educate our students regarding the importance of adherence to the school rules in the wearing of uniforms. We hope that the relaxation of the uniform rule will improve the students' comfort in the very warm weather. Please note that in Term 3, the school will revert to our usual uniform rules.

The students have been informed of these changes during morning assembly.
