The PSLE Written Examinations are from Thursday, 28th September 2023 to Wednesday, 4th October 2023. All P6 students are to report punctually to school at the usual reporting time. They will be dismissed from school at the end of each paper. Please refer to the PSLE Examination Booklet for specific dismissal timings.

P1 to P5 students will attend school as usual.

Similar to 2022, MOE will implement a study break for all P6 students from Monday, 25<sup>th</sup> September 2023 to Wednesday, 27<sup>th</sup> September 2023 to support student well-being.
