## Travel Declarations Online

For the upcoming end of year vacation, parents/guardians are required to inform the school of your child/ward's travel plans via the school's online Learning Management System, MC Online, [www.mconline.sg](http://www.mconline.sg). This system is compatible with Google Chrome Web Browser. You can declare your overseas travel plan via the School Admin Tab and choose "School Matters" and the "Travel Plan" option. All Primary One pupils are required to submit their declarations even if they do not intend to travel ("Not Travelling" declaration option is available). Pupils from other levels should declare their travel plans only if they are travelling. Pupils will be able to access the system using their own username and password. If necessary, please inform your child to seek their form teacher's assistance to reset password. The travel declaration has to be completed by **Fri 11 Nov 2016**.
