Travel Declarations Online

For the upcoming June School Holidays, parents are required to inform the school of your child travel plans via the school's online Learning Management System called MCOonline, www.mconline.sg. This system is compatible with Google Chrome Web Browser. You can declare your overseas travel plan via the School Admin Tab, choose "School Matters" and the "Travel Plan" option. All Primary One Students are required to submit their declarations even if they do not intend to travel ('Not Travelling' declaration option is available). Pupils from other levels should declare their travel plans only if they are travelling. Your child can seek assistance from his/her form teacher for help if they need to reset the password to their account. The travel declaration has to be completed by **Friday 25th May 2018**.
