PROJECT HONG BAO 2018

Tampines Primary School is collaborating with Tan Tock Seng Hospital in their community project, named Project Hong Bao 2018. This project aims to provide financial assistance to needy patients and supports healthcare innovation, research and training for the community to deliver better patient care.



Your child will be involved in designing their own red packet during the class activity as part of the CNY celebration in school on 15 Feb 2018. We would also want to encourage our pupils to donate part of their Hong Bao money or their daily pocket money to help the less fortunate in our community. They are to place their donation into the Hong Bao they made.



The school will be collecting the Hong Bao donation from the pupils upon their return to school after their CNY break.

The following are examples of some of the programmes that TTSH Community Fund supports.



COMMUNITY REHABILITATION PROGRAMME (CRP)

TTSH provides funds to support the rehabilitation programme for low-income patients, particularly those with stroke and neurological conditions who are unable to access expensive rehabilitation facilities in the community.



HELPING ELDERLY PATIENTS (HELP) PROGRAMME

There are many elderly patients in TTSH. Some of them are unable to afford their 'out of pocket' healthcare expenses. TTSH Community Fund supports them for these unsubsidised medical expenses, such as non-standard medication, interim dialysis, diapers, and dentures.



HELP ME GO HOME PROGRAMME

Patients who need breathing machines to stay alive would love to return home to their loved ones, but they cannot afford the high costs. TTSH Community Fund provides them with the expensive equipment so that they can go home to their families.



MOVING WITH EASE (MOVE) PROGRAMME

TTSH Community Fund provides needy patients with mobility aids like wheelchairs, prostheses, and transport services for their follow-up clinic sessions. Some of them may not have ramps and grab bars to move around the house easily. Others who



are discharged need customised ramps urgently. This Fund helps to create a safer home environment for patients to reduce the risk of falls
